REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL

Sealed Bids will be received by Black Hawk College, on or before December 1, 2021, by 2:00 p.m. prevailing time for the Black Hawk College Quad Cities Campus, East Campus, and Outreach Center Emergency Power Upgrades.

Lump sum bid proposals will be received for this project at the scheduled time of receipt of bids and will be publicly opened at that time. The bid opening will occur at the Quad Cities Campus, Building 1, Black Hawk Room No. 255, Black Hawk College, 6600 34th Avenue, Moline, Illinois 61265.

Bid security in the form of a bid bond, certified check, or cash in an amount equal to ten percent (10%) of the base bid amount shall be submitted with the bid. Should a bid bond be submitted, the bid bond shall be payable to the Board of Trustees, Black Hawk College.

Bids shall be submitted on or before the specified closing time in an opaque sealed envelope addressed to: Mike Meleg, Finance Office; Quad Cities Campus, Building 1 room 244A, Black Hawk College, 6600 34th Avenue, Moline, Illinois 61265.

A Pre-Bid Meeting will be held on November 17, 2021, at 10:00 a.m. at the Quad Cities Campus, Building 1, Black Hawk Room No. 255, 6600 34th Avenue, Moline, Illinois 61265. A second Pre-Bid Meeting will be held on November 18, 2021 at 10:00 a.m. at the East Campus, Vet Sciences Building, Auditorium Room 105, 26230 Black Hawk Road, Galva, Illinois 61434. Representatives from the College and the Engineer's office will be present to answer questions regarding bidding procedures and project requirements.

The College reserves the right to reject any or all bids or parts thereof, or waive any irregularities or informalities, and to make the award in the best interest of the College. Decisions of the College will be final.

All bidders must comply with applicable Illinois Law requiring the payment of prevailing wages by all contractors working on public projects. Bidders must comply with the Illinois Statutory requirements regarding labor, including Equal Employment Opportunity Laws.

Minority and Women Owned Businesses are highly encouraged to participate.
