

General Education Core Curriculum completion post-matriculation

Under the following circumstances, institutions will offer transfer students the option of satisfying lower-division general education requirements by completing a GECC curriculum while enrolled in the receiving institution.

- When the transfer student has completed a statewide articulated associate degree such as the AFA, AES, AAT; or
- When the transfer student has been granted 30 semester hours of transfer credit by the receiving institution without having completed the GECC. (Although not specified, the nature of lower-division curricula indicates that 30 semester hours of *transfer credit* from an IAI institution will likely incorporate GECC credits.)
